POLICY ON PERSONAL INFORMATION

1. Effective Date:

This Policy on Personal Information ('Policy') is effective from 16th March 2025 and it supersedes all existing policies on the subject matter.

2. Applicability:

This Policy applies to all personal data collected electronically by the School on this website or through your use thereof.

3. Definitions:

'Personal Data' for the purposes of this Policy means any information available or likely to be available with the School relating to a natural person, which is capable of identifying such person. Sensitive Personal Data means such personal information of a person which consists of information relating to:

Name of the Student;

His/her date of birth;

His/her gender;

His/her grade;

Name of his/her parent(s);

E-mail IDs of the parent(s);

Mobile number of the parent(s);

Password;

Financial information such as bank account or credit card or debit card or other payment instrument details;

Any detail relating to the above clauses as provided to the School by the person for providing any service.

4. Objective of Policy:

The School takes serious measures to maintain the trust that you place in us. To prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, to maintain data accuracy and to ensure the appropriate use of the information, the School utilizes appropriate physical, technical and administrative procedures to safeguard the information that is being collected.

5. Security Practices & Procedures:

The School ensures that all transactions with respect to Personal Data, including Sensitive personal data, shall:

Be processed fairly & lawfully.

Be obtained only with the consent of the information provider.

Be collected, only when:

The information is collected for a lawful purpose connected with a function or the School's activity and The collection of the sensitive personal data or information is considered necessary for that purpose. In respect of SENSITIVE PERSONAL DATA, the School ensures that it is not retained for a period longer than is required for the purposes for which the information may lawfully be used or is otherwise required under any law for the time being in force. Be available for review by the information provider, as and when requested. Be kept secure against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage, as per the prescribed standards.

The information collected under this Policy is being stored in the Digital Oceancloud webserver.

Disclosure of information: The School shall share your Sensitive Personal Data only with your express consent given under a contract or where the disclosure is necessary for compliance of a legal obligation or where required by government agencies mandated under law to procure such disclosure.

Transfer of Information: The School may transfer your Sensitive Personal Data to any body corporate or a person in India and ensure the same level of “data protection” is adhered to by such body corporate or person.

Publication: The School shall also not publish your Sensitive Personal Data and shall ensure that the information transferred to a third party is not further disclosed by it.

Authenticity: The School shall not be responsible for the authenticity of the Personal Data supplied to it by the provider, whose duty it is to ensure that the information provided by it or its employees is authentic.
